

Clarification of the “Native Desert Zone”

5.2.3 The Native Desert Zone

The Native Desert Zone is defined as the balance of the lot area *beyond yard walls and the 15’Foot transition zone, but no less than 30’ from the lot boundaries*. Native vegetation shall not be removed from these areas, and the soil surface shall neither be disturbed, *this extends to the use of Herbicide*, nor shall the ground surface be covered with decorative rock or other similar material. *Erosion control is the sole reason that the surface may be disturbed and this must be approved in advance by the Landscape Projects Committee*. ~~The soil surface may however be disturbed in order to control erosion (riprap) and the implementation of an approved plan for xeriscaping the site~~
