## Clarification of the "Native Desert Zone"

## 5.2.3 The Native Desert Zone

The Native Desert Zone is defined as the balance of the lot area <u>beyond</u> <u>yard walls and the 15'Foot transition zone</u>, <u>but no less than 30' from the lot boundaries</u> Native vegetation shall not be removed from these areas, and the soil surface shall neither be disturbed, <u>this extends to the use of Herbicide</u>, nor shall the ground surface be covered with decorative rock or other similar material. <u>Erosion control is the sole reason that the surface may be disturbed and this must be approved in advance by the Landscape Projects Committee</u> The soil surface may however be disturbed in order to control erosion (riprap) and the implementation of an approved plan for xeriscaping the site
